

What is Learn-to-Earn?

JIFF's Learn-to-Earn (LTE) program is designed to systematically address the high level of unemployed, unskilled, undereducated, out-of-school you and your adults ages 16 – 21, especially young offenders. JIFF serves youth and young adults from ten of Memphis' most socially and economically-challenged ZIP codes. JIFF offers three different modules for LTE participants — Culinary Arts Training and Career Readiness, GED and Career Readiness and Economic Advancement.

Learn-to-Earn is free to motivated people but registration is required and space is limited.

Culinary Arts Training and Career Readiness is provided for those participants who, through their occupational assessments and personal motivation, show proficiency and interest toward the food service industry. This training is based on the American Culinary Federation (ACF) guidelines and is administered on site in JIFF's commercial culinary arts training kitchen.

GED and Career Readiness is provided for those participants who have yet to earn a high school diploma or GED. JIFF is an official GED practice test site, recognized by the Messick Adult Center. JIFF also provides GED and Career Readiness participants with job placement and retention support services, post secondary education placement, or military placement.

Economic Advancement provides job placement, employment skills training, and retention support services for participants who have a GED or high school diploma and are in pursuit of post-secondary education. employment or who desire and opportunity to increase their marketable skills leading to more lucrative employment.
